**Directions:** The Community Hall is on Station Road, Woodbridge, IP12 4AU, adjacent to the Station Road car park (IP12 4AU). Parking is available here at £4.00 per day. Alternative car parking is available at £2.30 per day at Lime Kiln Quay car park, Deben Road, IP12 1AZ, about five minutes walk from the venue. The Lime Kiln Quay car park is small and fills up quickly on Saturday mornings, so be warned and arrive early. Station Road car park has ample spaces.

Woodbridge can be reached by train (station close to the venue) from Ipswich and Lowestoft, whilst bus services run from Ipswich.

**Lunch break.** Weather permitting, pre-packed lunches may be enjoyed on the banks of the River Deben, close to the Community Hall. Food outlets will be found near the station, with other eateries in the town centre, only a few minutes walk away. Woodbridge Museum (adjacent to the Saxon Ship Longshed) is well worth a visit if time permits during the lunch break or prior to 1630, and admission is free.
